- a safe recruitment form which should be completed and returned to school with the application form by the closing date of 12 noon, Monday 28th April 2025.
- a job description and person specification for the post. The person spec should be referred to when completing the application.

Lesson observations will take place in your current setting on either Tuesday 6th May or Wednesday 7th May 2025. Interviews will take place Friday 9th May. Successful shortlisted candidates should have been contacted no later than Thursday 1st May 2025.

This is initially a fixed term contract of one year. It is not a suitable post for Early Careers Teachers and we are looking for applicants with recent class teacher experience as well as an interest subject leadership of a core or foundation subject.
